- Academic ability and achievement (Year 5 and 6 reports)
- Skills in literacy and numeracy
- Ability to work independently
- Ability to think critically and creatively
- Primary teacher nomination
- Information from parents and caregivers on the expression of interest from.

If you would like your child to be considered for the Zenith class in 2024, please:

- 1. Complete and submit the attached application along with a copy or your child's Year 5 2022 End of Year report
- 2. Complete Expression of Interest (EOI) online for Hastings Secondary College via your child's primary school website.
- 3. Completed Zenith applications must be submitted to your child's school on or before **Thursday 6th April** or by email to our College Head Teacher, Michelle Garven.

Students will study the core curriculum with their year cohort, however the curriculum is compacted and made more challenging to allow time for enrichment, extension, problem solving and critical thinking skills.

Students applying for placement in a Zenith class may also apply for a position in one of the Academies (Sport, STEM or Creative Industries) or a Personal Interest Project (PIP). Academy and PIP classes will complement the Zenith program as they fit together as part of a weekly timetable.

Zenith students will have opportunities to participate in a range of academic, cultural and sporting extra curricular activities to enhance their learning. These include choir, band, Tournament of Minds, debating, specific programs run in partnership with our local universities and leadership opportunities.
